Honorary Secretary of State Application

The Honorary Secretary of State Program was established in January 2017 by WV Secretary of State Mac Warner. The Program seeks to recognize high school students who understand the importance of civic engagement of young adults who are qualified and eligible to vote.

In order to apply for the Honorary Secretary of State Program:

- 1. You must have actively participated in the voter registration efforts in your school;
- 2. Your school must have registered to vote at least 85 percent of the eligible students in the senior class; and
- 3. You must be recommended by your principal for the HSOS Program

The deadline to apply to be considered for the first round of HSOS Program recipients will be December 15th.

The deadline to apply for the second round of HSOS Program recipients is May 1st.
