First day to receive application for absentee ballot from military and overseas voters	January 1, 2018

Period to appoint ballot commissioners, if municipal executive committees exist	Jan. 15 - Jan. 30, 2018
Deadline to submit Notice of Intent for Class IV	Jan. 31, 2018
Notice of precinct change published	February 5, 2018
Deadline to order precinct change	March 7, 2018
Deadline for candidates to withdraw from General	March 13, 2018
First day to receive application for ballot by mail from all other voters (Except uniform and overseas voters)	March 13, 2018
Uniform drawing for ballot position [unless other dates set by ordinance]	March 27, 2018
Executive committees nominate poll workers	March 27, 2018
Deadline for emergency precinct change	April 6, 2018
Election officials & alternates appointed	April 17, 2018
Deadline for write-in candidate to file	April 17, 2018
Delivery of absentee ballots to recorder (deadline)	April 20, 2018
Mail absentee ballots	April 20 – May 31, 2018
Mandatory training of election officials (within 30 days of election)	May 6, 2018
Publish Sample Ballot (1st publishing)	May 10 - May 16, 2018

Last day to register to vote in a municipal election	May 15, 2018
Early voting occurs during this time period	May 23 - June 2, 2018
Early voting in person conducted 9 am to 5 pm	May 26, 2018
Publish Sample Ballot (2nd Publishing)	May 29 - June 4, 2018
Emergency absentee voting period	May 29 - June 5, 2018 (ends at noon on election day)
Deadline to receive all absentee ballot applications	May 30, 2018
Early voting in person conducted 9 am to 5 pm	June 2, 2018
Last day to receive a hand delivered absentee ballot	June 4, 2018
General Election day	June 5, 2018
Canvass begins; results declared at end of canvass	June 11, 2018
Certify results 48 hours after results declared for races without a recount request	June 13, 2018
New terms begin	July 1, 2018
