

VOTER IDENTITY AFFIDAVIT FOR VOTER PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION

Authority: W. Va. Code § 3-1-34(a)(3)

A voter does not have to show a valid identifying document to vote a regular ballot (*i.e.* not provisional) in-person at the polls during the early voting period or on Election Day if the voter meets the following criteria:

1. The voter is accompanied by an adult who has known the voter for at least six (6) months;
2. The adult shows a valid *photo* identifying document to the poll clerk confirming the adult's name, residence and photograph; and
3. The adult signs this Affidavit confirming the voter's identity and residence.

ALL FIELDS BELOW MUST BE COMPLETE BEFORE VOTER IS ISSUED A BALLOT
