

State of West Virginia Voter Identification Card Application

A West Virginia Voter ID Card may be provided to a West Virginia registered voter who has difficulty obtaining a valid identifying document to be presented at the polls on election day. West Virginia Voter ID cards are free-of-charge. **This application must be submitted IN PERSON to your County Clerk's office or to a representative of the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office.**

Persons with the following acceptable forms of valid identifying documents **do not need a Voter ID Card:**

- Driver's License
- Student Photo ID
- Medicare or SS Card
- Passport
- Military ID
- Voter Registration Card
- Government Photo ID
- Concealed Carry Permit
- Utility Bill
