SPOILED BALLOT RETURN ENVELOPE

POLL CLERKS:

If a voter returns a marked ballot to you indicating it has been spoiled, have the voter fold the ballot to obscure the face of the ballot. Take the ballot from the voter, write "spoiled" across the back of the ballot, and place in this envelope, along with any other spoiled ballot. Provide the voter with a new, signed ballot. At the end of Election Day, seal this envelope and return to the County Clerk.
