## Information for Completing Candidate's Certificate of Announcement

Any eligible person seeking nomination or election to an office or political party position to be filled by election in any primary or general election held within the state shall file a certificate of announcement declaring his or her candidacy for the nomination or election to the office. <sup>1</sup>

#### IMPORTANT REMINDERS

**1.** YOUR SIGNATURE MUST BE NOTARIZED.

2. YOU ARE SWEARING TO THE TRUTH OF THE INFORMATION PROVIDED.

#### THIS IS YOUR NOTICE OF THE BALLOT DRAWING

Your position on the ballot will be determined by RANDOM DRAWING at 9:00 A.M. FEBRUARY 20, 2024. Each county clerk will begin a drawing for ballot positions for all offices at this time. You *or* your representative may attend.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Check the box beside the date of the election on which the candidate seeks to appear on the ballot.
- 2. Enter the name of the office sought.
- **3.** Enter the district from which the office sought is elected.
  - Candidates must enter a district if seeking any of the following offices: U.S. House of Representatives,
     State Senate, House of Delegates, Conservation District Supervisor, or Greater Huntington Park &
     Recreation District.
  - Candidates must enter a circuit and division number if seeking any of the following judicial offices:
     Justice of the Supreme Court, Circuit Court Judge, Family Court Judge, and Magistrate.
- 4. Enter the full legal name of the candidate; this must include first middle, and last name.
- Enter the exact name the candidate desires to appear on the ballot, subject to the limitations prescribed in W.
   Va. Code §3-5-13 and WV CSR §153-14. (No more than 25 characters)
- 6. Enter the County of which the candidate is a resident and legally qualified voter.
  - **a.** County Commission and Board of Education candidates must enter the magisterial district in which they reside at the time of filing.
- **7.** Enter the house number, street name, city, state, and zip code of the address at which the candidate legally resides at the time of filing. (Do not enter a P.O. Box)
- 8. Enter the candidate's mailing address, if different than residence address.
- **9.** For Partisan Elections only: The name of the candidate's political party, as registered. The candidate must not have been registered as a voter affiliated with any other political party for a period of sixty (60) days before the date of the filing announcement. (Board of Education, Conservation District Supervisor, and judicial candidates should not list political affiliation.)

#### **OTHER REMINDERS**

#### 1. Pay the appropriate filing fee to the appropriate office.

- 2. File your certificate of announcement within the filing period. Filings received or postmarked before Monday, January 8, 2024, will be returned. Filings for all offices must be received by the correct filing officer or postmarked by the U.S. Postal Service no later than midnight on Saturday, January 27, 2024.
- **3.** Do not file for more than one office. If you file for more than one office and fail to withdraw from all but one office before the close of the filing period, you will not be placed on the ballot for any office.<sup>1,3</sup>
- **4.** If you decide to withdraw, you must do so by filing an application by the deadline. February 13, 2024 is the last day for your withdrawal to be received by the filing officer to remove your name from the primary election ballot.<sup>3</sup>
- 5. File your personal financial disclosure form with the West Virginia Ethics Commission within 10 days of filing your certificate of announcement. You may download this form at <u>ethics.wv.gov</u> or request it by calling the Ethics Commission at 304-558-0664. Candidates for federal offices and Delegate to National Convention are not required to file.

#### U.S. Senate<sup>8, 23</sup>

<u>Term:</u> 6 years <u>Minimum Age:</u> 30 years old <u>Residence:</u> Must be a citizen of the U.S. for 9 years *and* resident of West Virginia when elected

#### U.S. House of Representatives<sup>7, 23</sup>

<u>Term:</u> 2 years <u>Minimum Age:</u> 25 years old <u>Residence:</u> Must be a citizen of the U.S. for 7 years *and* a resident of West Virginia when elected

#### Governor<sup>10, 13, 14, 24</sup>

<u>Term:</u> 4 years – no more than 2 consecutive terms <u>Minimum Age:</u> 30 years old <u>Residence:</u> Must be a citizen of West Virginia for 5 years prior to election

Secretary of State<sup>13, 24</sup> Term: 4 years <u>Minimum Age:</u> 18 years old Residence: Must be a citizen of West Virginia

#### Justice of the Supreme Court of Appeals<sup>10, 16, 24</sup>

<u>Term:</u> 12 years <u>Minimum Age:</u> 30 years old <u>Residence:</u> Must be a citizen of West Virginia for 5 years prior to election <u>Requirements:</u> Must be in good standing with the WVSB; and admitted to practice law for at least 10 years prior to election

## Judge of the Intermediate Court of Appeals<sup>10, 16, 24</sup>

<u>Term:</u> 10 years <u>Minimum Age:</u> 30 years old <u>Residence:</u> Must be a citizen of West Virginia for 5 years prior to election <u>Requirements:</u> Must be in good standing with the WVSB; and admitted to practice law for at least 10 years prior to election

#### Circuit Judge<sup>15, 16, 25</sup>

Term: 8 years <u>Minimum Age:</u> 30 years old <u>Residence:</u> Must be a citizen of West Virginia for 5 years – must reside in the circuit served while in office <u>Requirements:</u> Must be in good standing with the WVSB; and admitted to practice law for at least 5 years prior to election

#### Family Court Judge<sup>16, 18</sup>

Term: 8 years

Minimum Age: 30 years old

<u>Residence</u>: Must be a citizen of West Virginia for 5 years prior to election – must reside in the circuit served while in office

<u>Requirements:</u> Must be in good standing with the WVSB; and admitted to practice law at least 5 years prior to election

#### Magistrate<sup>17, 25</sup>

Term: 4 years

<u>Minimum Age:</u> 21 years old by the time of taking office <u>Residence:</u> Must reside in the county served while in office

<u>Requirements:</u> Must have a high school education or equivalent. No more than one magistrate may be in an immediate family. No past felony conviction or any conviction for moral turpitude.

### County Commission<sup>21, 25</sup>

<u>Term:</u> 6 years <u>Minimum Age:</u> 18 years old <u>Residence:</u> Must reside in an open magisterial district

#### Prosecuting Attorney<sup>19, 25</sup>

<u>Term:</u> 4 years <u>Minimum Age:</u> 18 years old <u>Residence:</u> Must reside in West Virginia <u>Requirements:</u> Must be admitted to practice law by the time of filing for office.

#### Sheriff<sup>19, 20, 25</sup>

Term: 4 years – may only serve 2 consecutive terms Minimum Age: 18 years old Residence: Must reside in the county served

#### Assessor<sup>19, 25</sup>

<u>Term:</u> 4 years <u>Minimum Age:</u> 18 years old <u>Residence:</u> Must reside in the county served

#### Surveyor<sup>19, 25</sup>

<u>Term:</u> 4 years <u>Minimum Age:</u> 18 years old <u>Residence:</u> Must reside in the county served <u>Requirements:</u> No official duties or salary unless the county commission contracts with them for specific work

#### Conservation District Supervisor<sup>28</sup>

<u>Term:</u> 4 years <u>Minimum Age:</u> --<u>Residence:</u> --<u>Requirements:</u> Must own land in the district served and have education or experience in conservation.

#### Greater Huntington Park and Recreation District<sup>29</sup>

<u>Term:</u> 6 years <u>Minimum Age:</u> 18 years old <u>Residence:</u> Must reside in the district served

#### Board of Education<sup>27</sup>

<u>Term:</u> 4 years <u>Minimum Age:</u> 18 years old <u>Residence:</u> Must reside in an open magisterial district <u>Requirements:</u> Must have a high school education or equivalent. Training is required prior to taking office.
