<p style="text-align: center;">OFFICIAL BALLOT MINERAL COUNTY BRUNCH BILL ELECTION</p> <p>“Shall the beginning hour at which non-intoxicating beer, wine and alcoholic liquor be sold or dispensed for on premises consumption only in Mineral County on Sundays be changed from one o'clock p.m. to ten o'clock a.m.</p> <p>If approved by the voters this would allow private clubs and restaurants licensed to sell and dispense non-intoxicating beer, wine and alcoholic liquor; licensed private wine restaurants, private wine spas, private wine bed and breakfasts to sell and dispense wine; and licensed Class A retail dealers to sell and dispense non-intoxicating beer for on premises consumption only beginning at ten o'clock a.m. Additionally, if approved, it would also allow any mini-distilleries, wineries or farm wineries in this county to offer complimentary samples for on premises consumption only beginning at ten o'clock a.m.”</p> <p><b>Instructions to Voters:</b> To vote in favor of the Brunch Bill, darken the oval next to "For". To vote against the Amendment, darken the oval next to "Against the Amendment".</p> <p><input type="radio"/> For the Amendment</p> <p><input type="radio"/> Against the Amendment</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Amendment No. 2: Judicial Budget Oversight Amendment</b></p> <p><b>Summary of Purpose:</b> Providing that the total general revenue appropriations to the judiciary may be reduced in the budget bill, and setting forth the required procedures to be followed by the Legislature to enact any decrease in the total general revenue appropriations to the judiciary to an amount that is less than 85 percent of the amount of the total general revenue appropriations to the judiciary in the most recently enacted budget; providing that when requested by the Legislature, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Appeals must appear and be heard and answer inquiries relative any budget bill; and conforming language relating to the introduction of the budget and matters that may be taken up during extended sessions to more recent amendments to the constitution.</p> <p><b>Instructions to Voters:</b> To vote in favor of the Amendment, darken the oval next to "For the Amendment".
