Description of Columns A - E

- A. **Registered Voters as of 1/16/2017** - the number of registered votes as of 1/16/2017.
- B. **Registered Voters as of <Current Date>** - the number of registered voters as of the morning this report is produced.
- C. **Voters Cancelled 1/16/2017 – <Current Date>** - number of voter records changed from “Active” or “Inactive” status to “Cancelled” status from 1/16/2017 to the current date. Voters are only considered in this report if they currently have "Cancelled" status.
- D. **Percent Cancelled 1/16/2017 – <Current Date>** - the percent of voters cancelled since Secretary Warner took office ([C. “Voters Cancelled 1/16/2017 – <Current Date>”] / [A. “Registered Voters as of 1/16/2017”]).
- E. **New Registrations since 1/16/2017** - This number is based on the total voters registered with a “Registration Date” equal to or greater than 1/16/2017. **Note:** When a voter moves from one county to another, he or she is counted as a “New Registration.”
